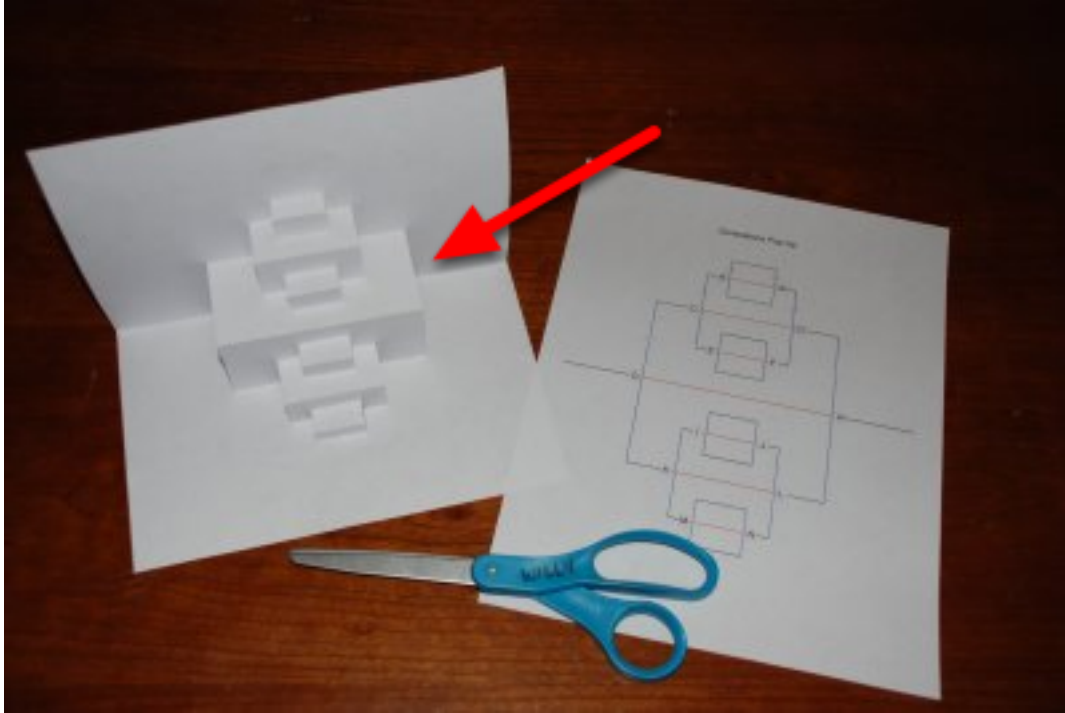


Step Pop-Up Instructions

Materials

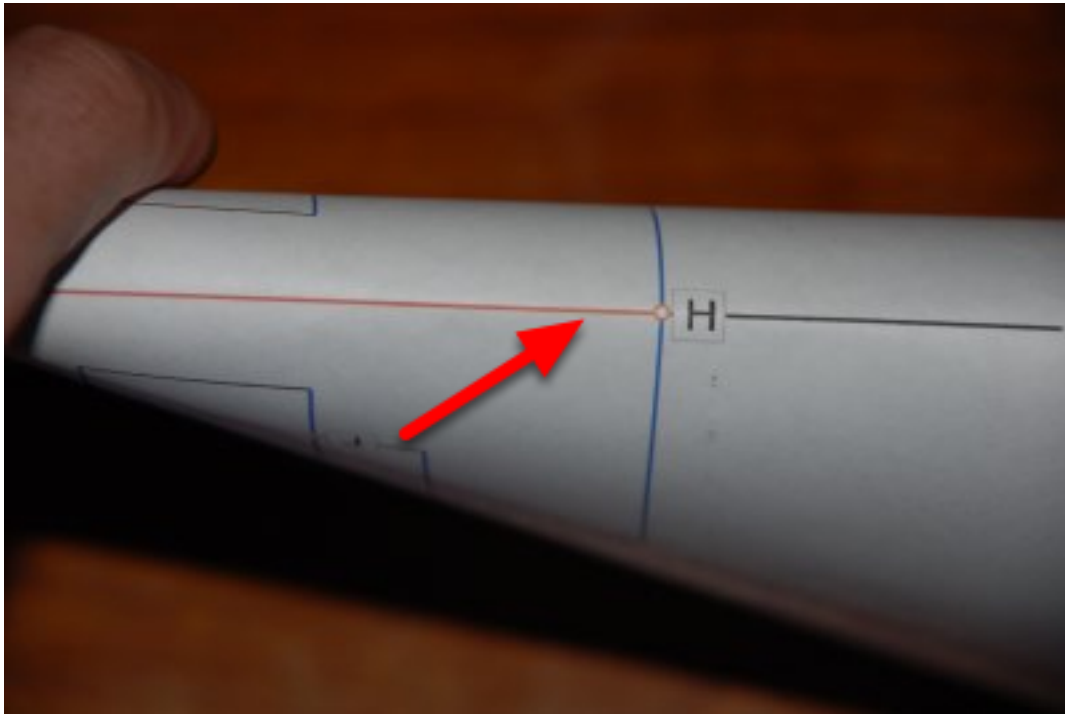


To make a pop-up like the one on the left (see arrow), you will need the following materials:

1. Step Pop-Up Template*
2. Scissors

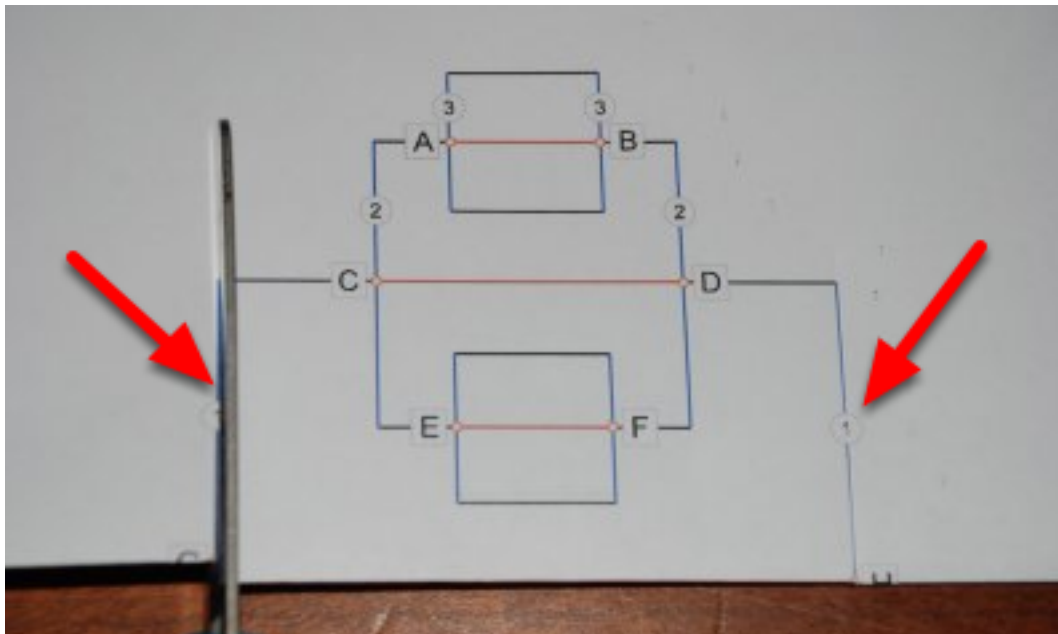

Step 1: Fold Paper in Half



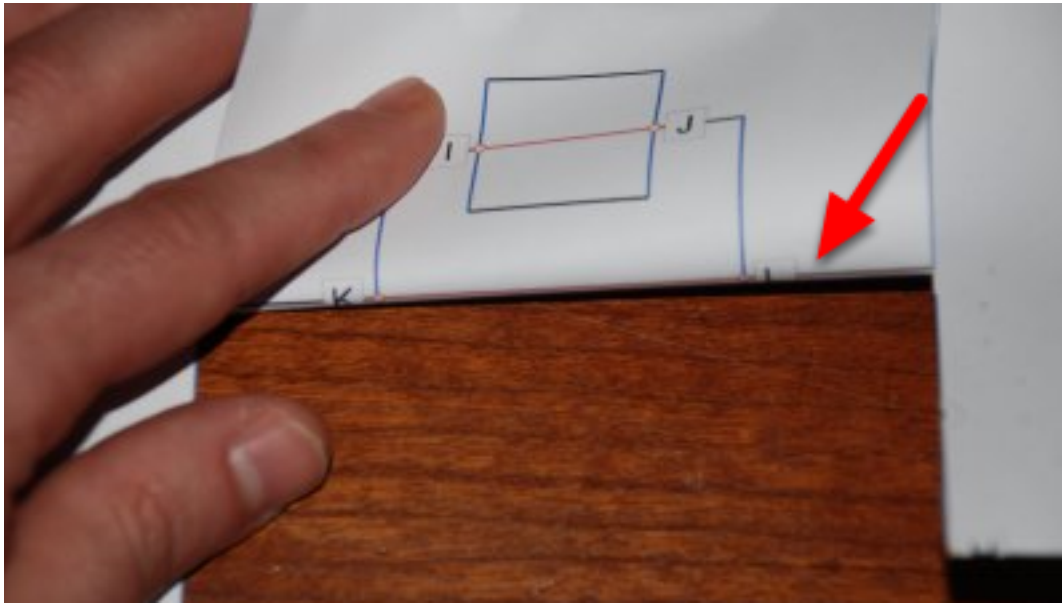
Fold the sheet of paper in half along the line that is marked with a G and H. Make sure to fold the paper so that you can see the printed lines and numbers.

Step 2: Cut Lines



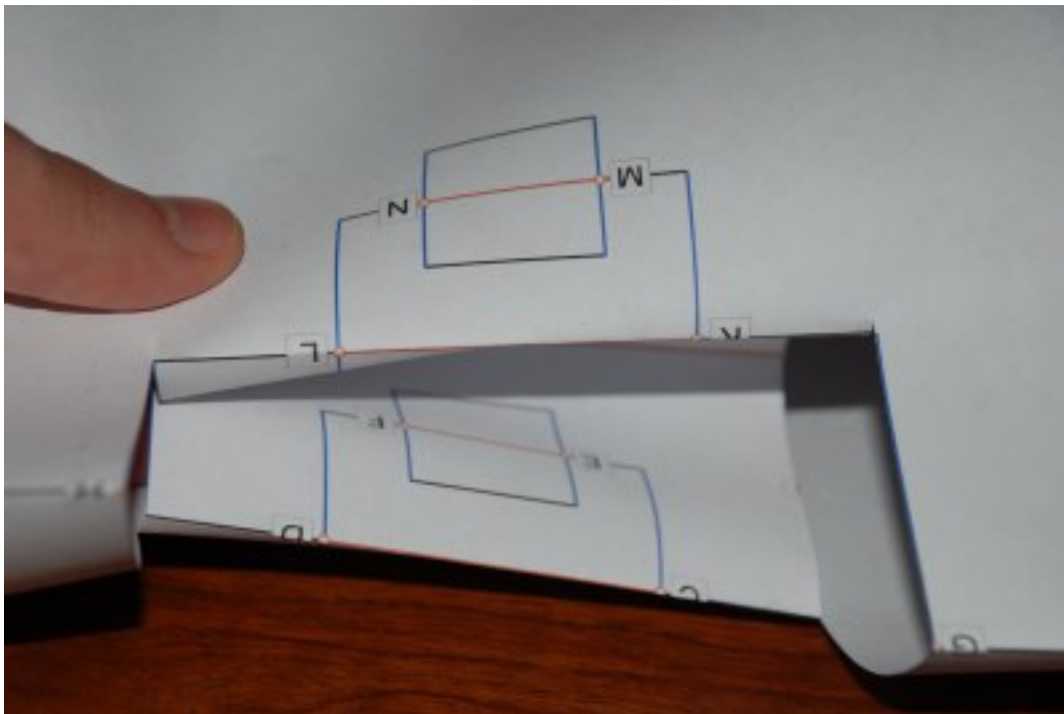
Cut the blue lines that are marked with a 1. Make sure that you cut both- there are two!

Step 3: Fold



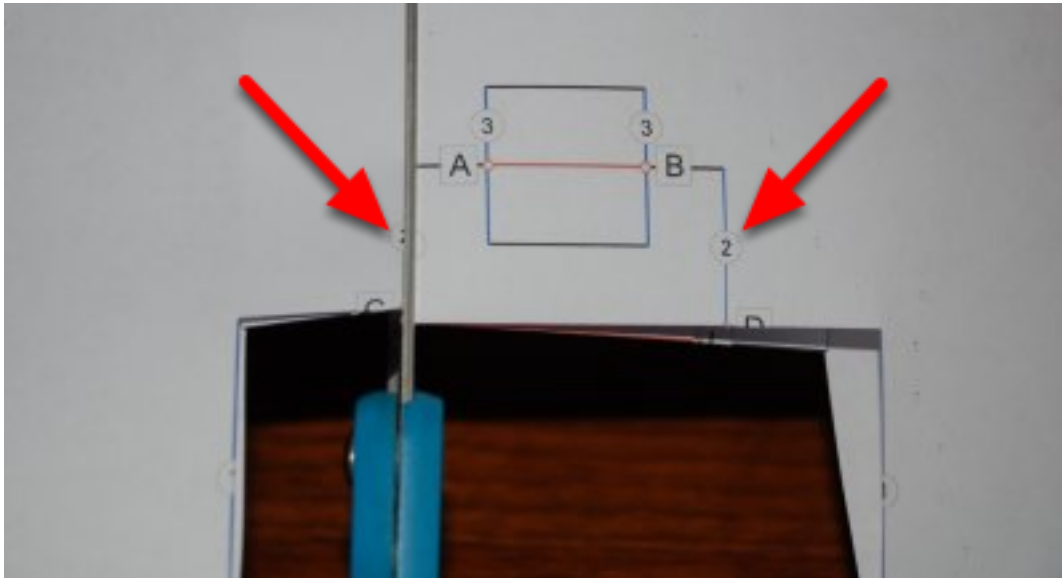
Fold the created flap forward and make a hard crease on the guiding line marked with a "K and L" or a "C and D." You can make a hard crease by running your finger over the folded paper.

Step 4: Push Flap Inside



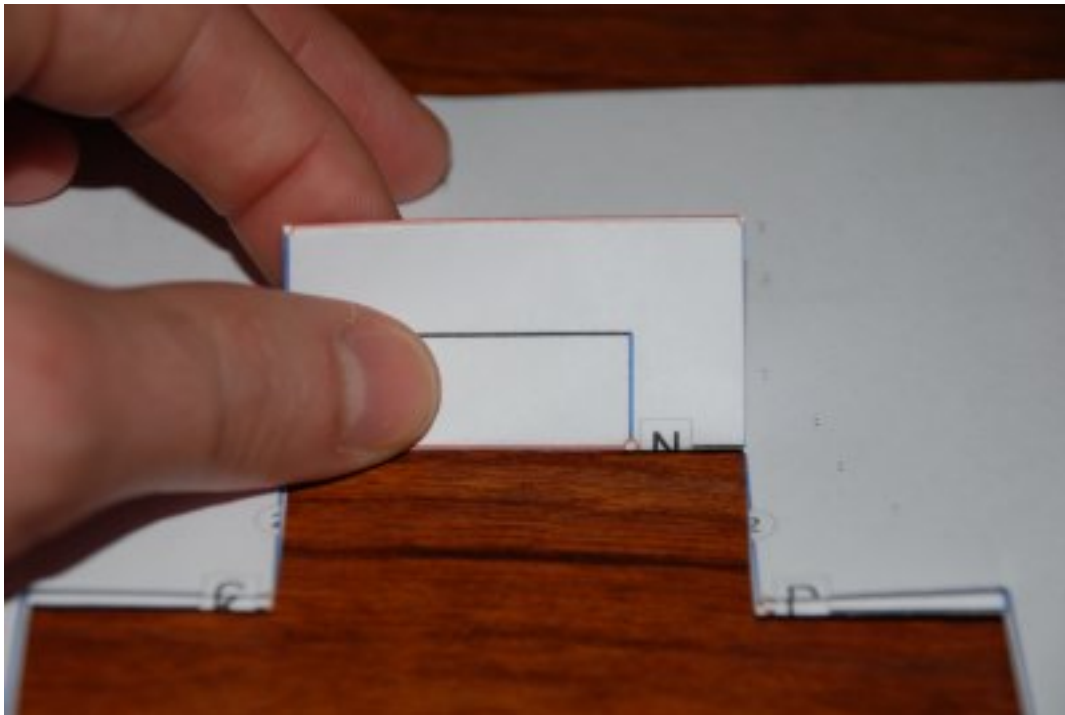
Push the flap "inside" of the paper and flatten the design. Although not particularly hard, this is one of the trickier steps in making this pop-up. Visit <http://tinyurl.com/StepPop259> to watch a video that shows how to complete step 4.

Step 5: Cut Lines



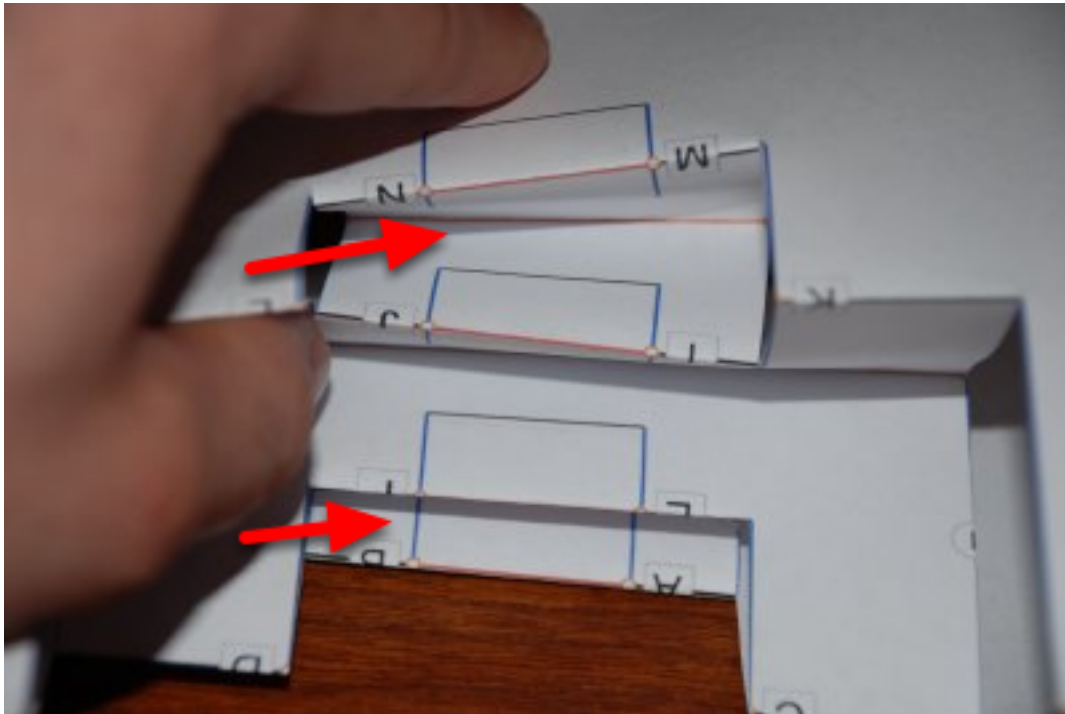
Cut the blue lines that are marked with a 2. Make sure that you cut both- there are two!

Step 6: Fold



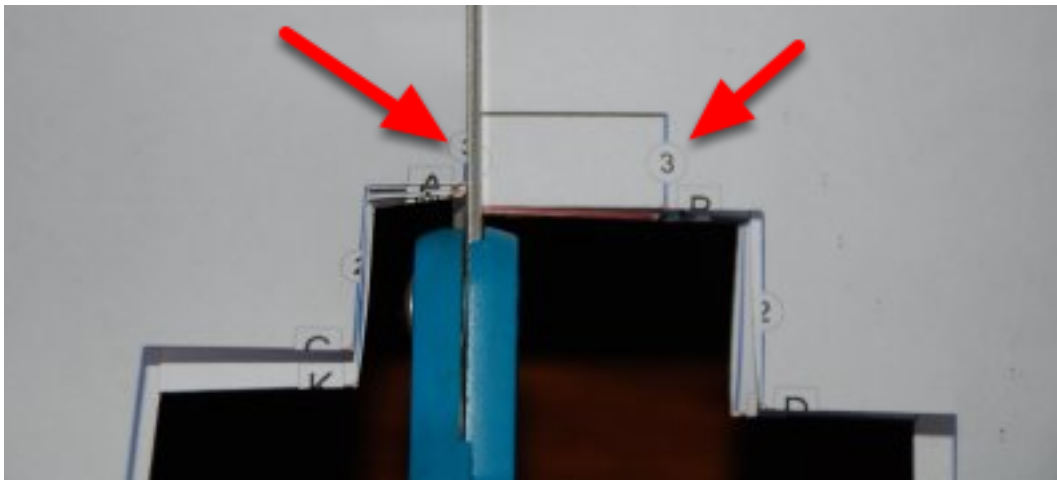
Fold the created flap forward and make a hard crease on the guiding line marked with a "M and N" or a "A and B." You can make a hard crease by running your finger over the folded paper.

Step 7: Push Flaps Inside



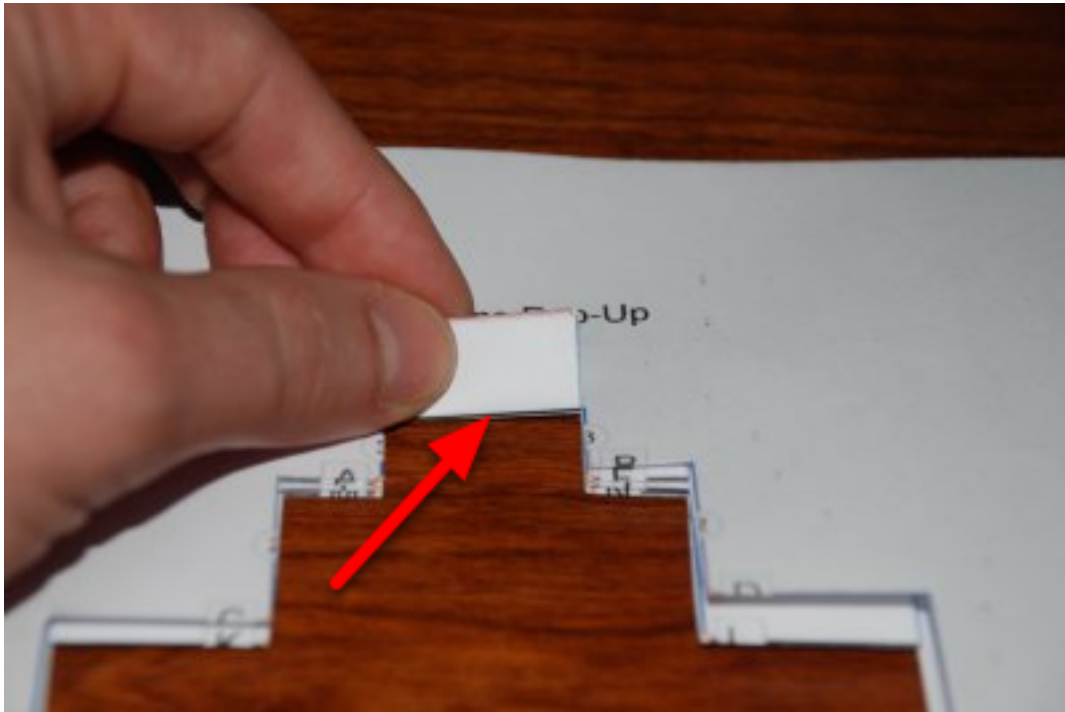
Push the flaps "inside" of the paper and flatten the design. Visit <http://tinyurl.com/StepPop449> to watch a video that shows how to complete step 4.

Step 8: Cut Lines



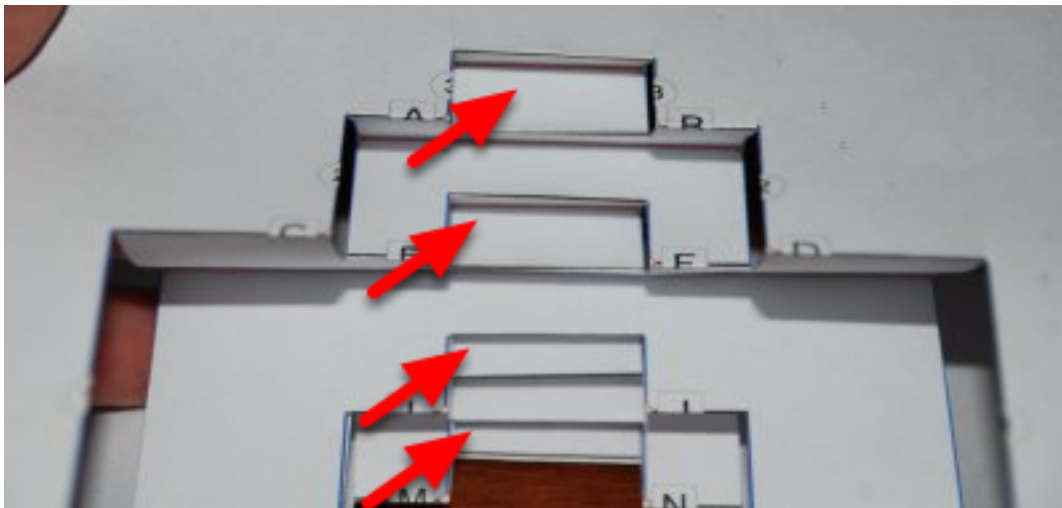
Cut the blue lines that are marked with a 3. Make sure that you cut both- there are two!

Step 9: Fold



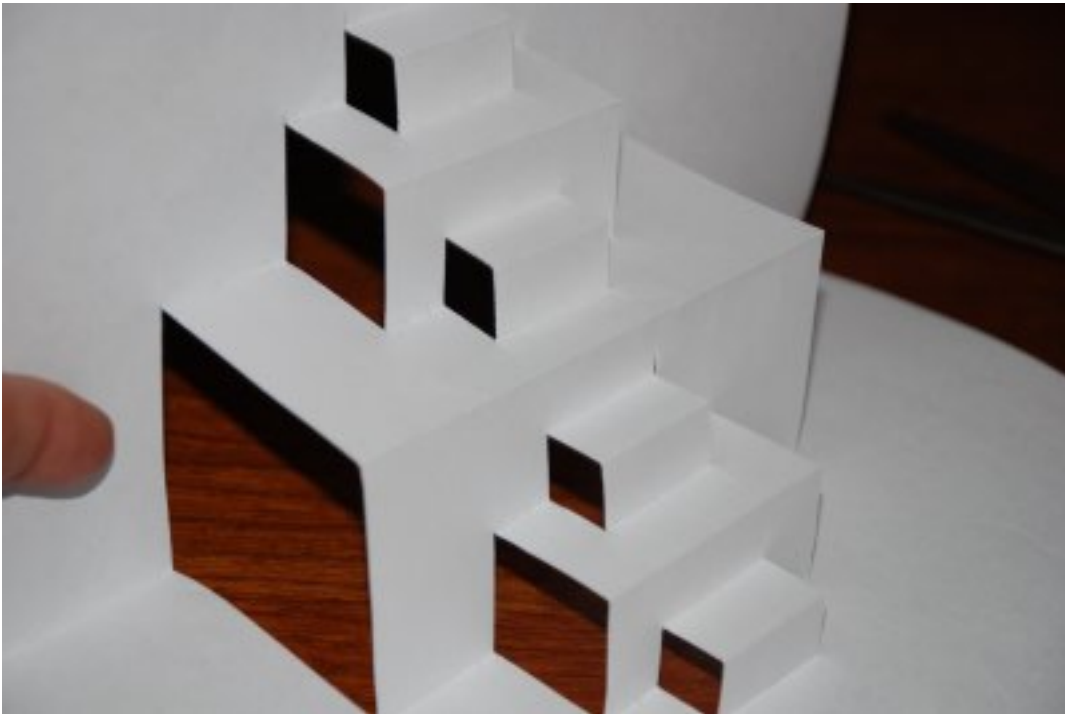
Fold the created flaps forward and make a hard crease on the guiding line similar to what you did in previous steps. You can make a hard crease by running your finger over the folded paper.

Step 10: Push Flaps Inside



Push the flaps "inside" of the paper and flatten the design. This process is the same as steps 4 and 7.

Step 11: Open



The final step is to open the blank side of the folded design to reveal the step pop-up.
